Approximately 1 minute before the sequence begins – 3 short horn blasts will be given to let everyone know that races are about to start.

5 minutes before the before the start of a class the class flag is raised, accompanied by a horn blast.

4 minutes before the start the “P” flag is raised, accompanied by a horn blast.

1 minute before the start the “P” flag is removed, accompanied by a horn blast.

At the start of the race the class flag is removed, accompanied by a horn blast.

Additional detail:

All engines must be stopped by the 4 minutes to go blast (“P” flag)

For our club races the first race of the day will start at 12 noon. All boats start at the same time.

Our club races begin .3 NM down wind of R2 at the mouth of Edenton Bay between the RC, and an orange spherical float - if there is no RC then the start will be between 2 orange spherical floats. The racecourse will be announced over the radio on channel 68 prior to the start. The finish is at R2. If we have no RC the helmsman will call “MARK” over channel 68 when he comes abeam of a marker R2 on an imaginary line extending west of R2 and perpendicular to a line from the last mark. The boat must be within 2 boat lengths of R2 along the imaginary line for a proper finish.
